Pastor's Message

Our Lady of Fatima - 100 Year Anniversary of the Apparitions. The apparitions began May 13, 1917 and ended October 13, 1917. In the year 1916, the three children had three visits from St. Michael the Archangel to prepare them for our Lady's apparitions in 1917.

1.The main message from Our Lady was Penance, meaning a conversion of one's life, a turning away from sin and turning back to God. “Men must amend their lives and ask pardon for their sins. They must on longer offend God, who is already so much offended.

2. Prayer - and especially the Rosary. “You must recite the Rosary every day in honour of Our Lady of the Rosary to obtain peace for the world and the end of the war (WWI) for only she can obtain this.”

3. Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. One June 13, 1917, Mary said, “Jesus wishes to establish throughout the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart.”

Pope Benedict said in the year 2010, that he hoped the Triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary will have occurred by the 2017. We are still waiting and praying.
